Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of accused petitioner-Jagjiwan Pal Singh in case FIR No.85 dated 21.03.2016, under Sections 147, 149, 456, 457, 447, 448, 395, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Ambala Cantt., Ambala.

As per investigating agency, name of the petitioner has surfaced as one of the conspirators and accompanying the other co-accused while attempting to take forcible possession of property in dispute on the night of 20.3.2016 at around 8 pm.

It was contended that the petitioner is a Contractor and owner of a Rice Mill and has no criminal antecedents. His name has been included only on the basis of call details with principal accused Himalyani Gupta and Smt. Promila Kanwar, who have since been enlarged on regular bail. It was further submitted that as such nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused further submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by Inspector Sukhvinder Singh, agrees that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 27.04.2016, is made absolute.
