TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.50 dated 11.03.2016, under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala, District Patiala.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length and the case paper book has been perused.

FIR came to be registered on the complaint of Jagdish Kaur. Allegations are that a certain parcel of land was sold by the complainant to the wife of the present petitioner, namely, Sukhwinder Kaur as also to one Gurmeet Kaur by way of a registered sale deed dated 01.02.2013 but the sale consideration of Rs.18 lac has not been paid. Complainant's version was that Rs.70,000/- was paid by cash and the balance amount of Rs.18 lacs by way of cheque and

upon presentation has been dishonoured.

Counsel appearing for the petitioner would press the instant petition seeking quashing only on the ground that the petitioner has bonafide intent of settling the matter and is ready to enter into a compromise on mutually agreed terms and conditions. Counsel has argued that the present petition be entertained on such ground as otherwise the parties would continue to litigate and which would also amount to wasting the time of the Court.

Suffice it to observe that such contention and submission is not tenable and acceptable for this Court to entertain the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing an FIR.

It is not the case made out by the counsel that if the allegations contained in the FIR are taken on their face value still no offence would be made out against the present petitioner.

The present petition is only misconceived and is dismissed.
