Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.102 dated 13.9.2014, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

The allegation against the petitioner is that recovery of 130 grams of intoxicating powder i.e. *Alprazolam* was effected from the petitioner.

Learned State counsel states that the FSL report has been received in this case in which, it has been reported that the ingredient i.e. *Alprazolam* was found in 130 grams of intoxicating powder, recovered from the petitioner. He further states that there is one other case of similar nature

also against the petitioner, wherein recovery of 270 grams of intoxicating powder was recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Taking into consideration the recovery of 130 grams of intoxicating powder effected from the petitioner coupled with the fact that there is another case against the petitioner of similar nature, wherein, recovery of 270 grams of intoxicating powder was effected from the petitioner, no ground for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
