Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 9 and provide adequate security to him.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State has filed reply on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 by way of affidavit of Davinder Singh, PPS, DSP, Bassi Pathan. The same is taken on record. On the strength of the reply, he submits that as many as 06 cases have been registered against the petitioner whereas 32 cases have been registered against the father of the petitioner and most of the cases are under the Gambling Act. He further submits that under the garb of the present petition, he is mounting pressure upon the prosecution.

Considering the details, as reflected in the reply, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and the same is accordingly dismissed.
