The petitioner/accused-Khushal Singh is seeking the transfer of investigations of FIR No.0011 dated 22.01.2016, under Sections 323, 324 and 326/34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Jakhal, District Fatehabad, and also a direction for providing adequate security to himself.

The petitioner is an accused in the aforesaid FIR with the allegations of having inflicted a incised wound with his *Barcha* blow on the left hand of the complainant-Balbir Singh @ Bhira in a street fight at around 11:00 PM on 21.01.2016. The petitioner is on interim pre-arrest bail.

It is contended that the father and brother of the petitioner were first attacked by the complainant party and that had resulted into injuries upon them. The grievance of the petitioner is that their version has not been looked into by the police. Serious prejudice is attributed to the I.O./ASI Suresh Kumar, who is stated to be helping the other party. A representation dated 01.02.2016 (**Annexure P-3**) made to the S.P., Fatehabad has also not been addressed.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner heard at length.

The investigations on the aforesaid ground alone cannot be transferred and the stand of the petitioner even if it is believed to be true, in that event, the petitioner can adopt other legal remedies in accordance with law including setting up his/their case by way of a private complaint. The facts and circumstances of the case do not warrant invoking the inherent powers of this Court.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
