Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to act on the FIR No.215 dated 5.11.2015 under Sections 341, 506, 324, 323 and 120-B read with Section 34 IPC and Section 307 IPC (added later on).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though the FIR was registered on 5.11.2015, but no action has been taken thereon so far. He further submits that after registration of the FIR, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 5.1.2016 (Annexure P-3) (colly) and at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 i.e.

Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to look into the contents of said representation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting upon the contents of representation (Annexure P-3), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take note of the contents of representation dated 5.1.2016 (Annexure P-3) and to act in accordance with law.
