Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 141 dated 30.12.2014 under Section 420 IPC, PS Ramdass,Distt.Amritsar.

As per allegations levelled by complainant Harpal Singh, petitioner-Dilbagh Singh alongwith non-applicants/accused Taranjit Singh, Ramandeep Kaur and Kuldip Kaur had received a sum of Rs.2.02 lacs for sending his son Navjot Singh to Malaysia on work permit. He was, however, sent on tourist visa only.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that co-accused Taranjit Singh has already been granted bail; from the allegations no offence is made out; the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.
