Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No. 45, dated 06.02.2014, for offences punishable under Sections 379, 188, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 of Explosive Act, registered at Police Station Tauru, District Mewat.

The petitioner was found to be involved into illegally mining of the stones from the Arawali Hills in violation of the orders passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court. The petitioner was enlarged on bail on 18.03.2014. He absented himself on 15.09.2014 and thereafter was taken in custody on 17.12.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length.

It is apparent that after presentation of challan on 11.06.2014, the trial could not be proceeded due to the deliberate absence of the petitioner. Such conduct of the petitioner is viewed very seriously. Hence, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
