Report dated 18.05.2016 sent by learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division)-Cum-Sub-Division Judicial Magistrate, Malerkotla has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Dalip Kumar as well as of complainant Lalit Kumar Goyal it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a pure money dispute and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR**

Criminal 1052, FIR No.214 dated 30.08.2004 under Section 420 IPC Police Station, City II, Malerkotla, District Sangrur and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.

Petition stands disposed off.
