JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No. 93 dated 11.10.2008 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Rahon and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom as well as order dated 19.12.2012 (Annexure P-2) whereby, petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender.

2. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to surrender before trial Court to face trial, in case, some sort of protection is provided to him by allowing him bail by the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate by keeping the operation of order dated December 19, 2012 (Annexure P-2) in abeyance.

3. Undoubtedly, neither the complainant nor the witnesses cited by the prosecution did support the case of the prosecution and they were declared

hostile. As a result whereof, the co-accused namely Bachittar Singh and others were acquitted. Thus, instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before trial Court within a week to face trial and in case he applies for bail, that should be allowed by the trial Court at its satisfaction.
