Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.94 dated 10.12.2007 (Annexure P-2) under Section 379 IPC, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Churrian, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 20.3.2014 (Annexure P-3).

This Court vide order dated 22.4.2014 directed the parties to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to get their statements recorded in support of the compromise. Thereafter, one another

opportunity was granted vide order dated 26.2.2015 to get their statements recorded.

Learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala has reported that respondent No.2 i.e. Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Batala, at whose instance the FIR was registered, has not come forward to get his statement recorded.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid fact, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of the present petition, however, with liberty to file fresh one for quashing of FIR on merits.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
