JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by Suresh Kumar-petitioner seeking direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect his life and liberty, at the hands of respondents No.5 to 8 as they are extending threats to implicate him in false criminal cases with further direction to the official respondents to register a criminal case on the basis of complaint dated 14.03.2016 (Annexure P-3) moved by him and to take appropriate action.

2. Notice of motion to official respondents only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Ms. Neelam Kashyap, DAG, Haryana has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the

petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.

4. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that though a detailed complaint dated 14.03.2016 (Annexure P-3) was moved but till date no action has been taken rather, the complainant is being harassed and is being summoned time and again by the police and is being pressurized for withdrawal of the complaint.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Jind to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his complaint dated 14.03.2016 (Annexure P-3) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. At the same time, official respondents are directed not to call the petitioner time and again except for recording his statement or for production of any evidence by him.
