1. Whether reporters of local newspapers may be allowed to see judgment?

HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to ensure the security of life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 10.

Prayer has also been made for a issuance of a direction to the official respondents to restrain respondents No.4 to 10 from interfering in the peaceful possession of the petitioners over the land on which the petitioners want to harvest the wheat crop belonging to the petitioners as well as for taking legal action against respondents No.4 to 10 for threatening and humiliating the petitioners.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner confines his prayer to the extent of protection of life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 10. He states that in order to seek protection of life and liberty, the petitioners have approached respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur and made a representation dated 23.4.2016 (Annexure P-3), but no action has been taken on the said representation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting upon the contents of representation (Annexure P-3), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the prayer of the petitioners for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 10 in accordance with law.
