JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Prayer is under section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Bikramjit Kumar Kalia and Surinder Kaur in case FIR No.5 dated 15.02.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Dhar Kalan, District Pathankot.

There were allegations of the petitioner accused having received a total sum for Rs.18 lacs from six persons on the false pretext of getting them recruited in the Railways.

It is further revealed that an agreement had been arrived at for returning amount of Rs.11.5 lacs to the complainant and other victims as

full and final settlement.

Counsel for the parties heard at length.

Although there is yet another alleged compromise whereby a total sum of Rs.5 lacs was to be paid which has not seen the light of the day.

However, concededly even the said total amount has not been paid so far.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
