Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 438, Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, Satish Kumar, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 326, 427, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, in a case arising out of FIR No.178, dated 27.10.2015, registered at Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib.

It is stated that there is a version and cross version over a quarrel which occurred on the spur of moment between two neighbouring shopkeepers.

As per allegations, present accused-Satish Kumar is alleged to have inflicted *kappa* blow, which hit little finger of left hand causing a bone deep injury.

Upon notice, learned Counsel for the complainant along with his client is present in the Court. He submits that there is no possibility of an amicable settlement.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by H.C. Vakil Singh, submits that after investigation, cancellation report has been prepared and is awaiting approval.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
