JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure read with Article 21 of Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners and to provide them security, as they are apprehending threats at the hands of respondents No.2 to 4.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that though a representation (Annexure P-1) was moved to respondent No.3 but till date no action has been taken on the said representation. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 3 to decide the representation within a stipulated period.

3. Notice to respondents No. 1 to 3 only at this stage.

4. At the asking of Court, Ms. Neelam Kashyap, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Haryana. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Mewat, Haryana to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their representation (Annexure P-1) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
