The present writ petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondents to decide various representations filed by the petitioners.

2. The claim made in the present petition is that the petitioners are not liable to pay the tax under the provisions of The Punjab Passengers and Goods Taxation Act, 1952 (as applicable to Haryana) on the buses carrying the students of the petitioners institute. He further submitted that the issue has already been gone into by a Division Bench of this Court in **CWP No. 8643 of 2005, titled as Apeejay College of Engineering Vs. State of Haryana and another, decided on 10.04.2015,**

3. Learned counsel for the State submitted that the representations filed by the petitioners shall be considered and decided in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.

4. In view of the fair stand taken by learned counsel for the parties, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Excise and Taxation Commissioner, Haryana to decide the representations made by the petitioners within a period of four months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
