This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.180 dated 06.07.2015 registered under Sections 302/34 IPC and 25/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Barauda, District Sonapat.

As per the allegation the petitioner is alleged to have informed the main accused about the departure of the victim and thereafter the ambush was laid.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody since 04.08.2015. He further states that his antecedents are absolutely clear and only evidence which emerged against him is the disclosure statement of the co-accused.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Ravi Kumar has accepted these factual assertions.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the nature of the allegations against the petitioner and the fact that trial is not likely to be concluded in near future, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

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Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
