The appellant has questioned order of termination dated 19.09.1978 before the trial Court. The petitioner-appellant filed a suit challenging order of his termination dated 19.09.1978, which was decreed in favour of the petitioner-appellant. The appellate Court reverse the order of the trial Court. Feeling aggrieved by the same, present appeal has been filed.

By virtue of impugned order, the appellant was continued in service. During pendency of the appeal, it is stated that the appellant was once again dismissed from service on 07.01.1997.

In these circumstances, the present regular second appeal do not survive for consideration. Accordingly, the same is dismissed.

However, liberty is granted to appellant to revive this appeal, if he is not dismissed from service on 07.01.1997.
