The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.30 dated 17.6.2010 under Sections 326, 324, 323, 447, 511, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Khemkaran, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P1) along with all the consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 19.4.2015 (Annexure P2).

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Patti received. Statements of the complainant as well as accused have been recorded. It is reported that the parties have compromised the matter and the same is without any pressure, undue influence or

coercion. Case is stated to be at the stage of prosecution evidence.

Since the parties have amicably settled the dispute and it is an injury case, therefore, FIR No.30 dated 17.6.2010 under Sections 326, 324, 323, 447, 511, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Khemkaran, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P1) along with all the consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition stands allowed.
