JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 to perform their imperative corresponding duty to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to ensure that the petitioners are not hounded by police by way of late night raids.

The contention of learned counsel for the petitioners is that though a representation (Annexure P-4) was made to Director

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General of Police, Chandigarh, but till date no action has been taken. He further contends that Harjit Singh Brar (Former Superintendent of Police/Assistant Deputy Commissioner of Police, Amritsar) – respondent No.5 has been bent upon to register a false case against the petitioners and other police officials are extending threats to their life and liberty at his instance.

The instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the Director General of Police, Ferozepur to look into the grievances unfolded in the representation dated April 01, 2016 (Annexure P-4) personally and take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
