This order shall dispose of above referred two petitions. For
the sake of convenience the facts are being taken from CRM-M-14297 of
2016.

These petitions have been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioners under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.66 dated 11.03.2014 registered under Sections 15/61/85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioner - Jasvir Singh @ Seera has been in custody since 27.01.2016 and the petitioner – Lucky has been in custody since 29.02.2016 and they were not arrested from the spot.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from H.C. Gurpreet Singh has accepted the fact that the petitioners were not arrested from the spot but states that as per the investigation the car which was seized belongs to the petitioner – Lucky.

Since the petitioners were not arrested from the spot and keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioners on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Both the petitions stand allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
