Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Joga Singh in case FIR No.0055 dated 15.03.2016 for the offences punishable under Sections 306/34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Rama Mandi, Jalandhar.

As per the allegations, the petitioner-accused was having illicit relation with Karamjit Kaur, which led to her husband-Dharampal to commit suicide.

It is contended that neither there is a suicide note nor any material which would show the complicity of the petitioner-accused in abetting the commission of the suicide by Dharampal.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Jatinder Bir Singh, agrees that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 28.04.2016, is made absolute.
