RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners had approached this Court aggrieved by the act of the Police Department in deputing respondents No.5 to 15 to the Upper School cadre in spite of the fact that they were junior to them.

2. In the written statement filed on behalf of the respondents, it has been stated that respondents No.5 to 15 had joined their duties as ASIs prior to the petitioners i.e. between October 27, 1989 to November 30, 1989.

3. Notice of motion in this case was issued on April 10, 1996. The issue involved was formulated by the Division Bench on May 08, 1996 after which the matter was admitted on May 17, 1996.

4. No one appears for the petitioners. After the passage of two decades any attempt to retrieve relief would be difficult, if not impossible.

5. This petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

6. If the parties have any grievance remaining, they would remain at liberty to apply for the revival of the petition.
