The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.49 dated 15.04.2016 registered under Sections 323, 325, 341 and 34 IPC at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The investigating officer ASI Bhupinder Singh makes statement that the complainant-Nishan Singh is present before the court and he identifies him with responsibility.

Learned State counsel submits that challan has not yet been filed.

There is affidavit tendered by respondent No.2-complainant, who is present in person in court and has been identified. The affidavit is taken on record as part and parcel of the office record.

In view of the compromise that has been arrived at, I think the party should be allowed to compound/compromise. Hence I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-14334 OF 2016 is allowed in terms of the prayer clause in the petition.
- (ii) The FIR No.49 dated 15.04.2016 registered under Sections 323, 325, 341 and 34 IPC at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala, is quashed and set aside along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, subject to deposit of ₹5,000/- each by the petitioners in the Police welfare fund within a period of three months from today.
