This is the second petition filed before this Court under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners herein in case FIR No.35 dated 12.02.2016, under Sections 148/149/323/324/341/506 of Indian Penal Code and Section 326 (added later on) registered at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala.

The earlier petition was preferred by a different counsel and which was permitted to be dismissed as withdrawn on the statement made by counsel i.e. Mr. Anurag Arora, Advocate.

The maintainability of the present petition is justified by Mr. Abhishek Sethi, learned counsel by stating that in a connected petition i.e. CRM No.M-13095 of 2016 notice of motion has been

issued.

It may be noticed that in the light of order carrying even date even such petition i.e. CRM No.M-13095 of 2016 has been dealt with and has been dismissed.

Be that as it may even on merits, it may be noticed that in an occurrence that took place on 11.02.2016, two persons suffered injuries, namely, the complainant Harpreet Saini and one Rohit.

Insofar as present petitioner No.1 Ravi Khan is concerned, the specific attribution is of being armed with a *gandasi* and having landed a blow on the right hand of Rohit. Insofar as petitioner No.2 is concerned, he is also stated to be armed with *gandasi* and having landed a blow on the head of Rohit. Both the injuries attributed to the present petitioners and on the person of Rohit have been opined to be grievous in nature and have attracted offence under Section 326 IPC.

Prayer in the present petition seeking concession of anticipatory bail is declined on the face of such specific and serious injuries attributed.

Petition is dismissed.
