Present petition has been filed praying for the directions for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners, who have entered into matrimony against the wishes of their parents.

Pusuant to the order dated 28.04.2016 passed by this Court, learned counsel for the petitoners has produced photocopies of FDRs for an amount of Rs.51,000/- and Rs.49,000/- in the name of petitioner No.1-Sheenu Bala, for a term of three years. The same are taken on record. He further undertakes not to

withdraw the said FDRs before its maturity.

Learned counsel for respondent No.5 submits that no harm will be caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents, as they do not have any objection to the matrimonial alliance.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is accordingly disposed of.

However, in case the petitioners still apprehend any threat to their life and liberty, they are at liberty to approach the concerned SSP, who shall take necessary steps for redressal of their grievance in accordance with law.
