Report dated 05.05.2016 sent by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barnala has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Nasib Singh Kular, Sandeep Kaur Kular, Parminder Kaur Kular and Zora Singh Kular as well as of complainant Jaswant Kaur Bhathal it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the offences are not heinous in nature and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long

way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.199 dated 28.07.2014 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC Police Station, City Barnala and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
