Report dated 28.07.2016 sent by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Manjit Kaur, Satinderjit Singh, Faquir Singh and Navjot Kaur as well as of complainants Paramjit Kaur, Bhajan Kaur it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the offences are not heinous in nature and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long

way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.5 dated 15.01.2016 under Sections 323,324,341,34 IPC Police Station, Sadar, Kapurthala and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
