JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Mahil Singh-petitioner seeking direction to respondents No. 1 to 4 to take action as per the law on the complaint dated February 23, 2016 (Annexure P-2) preferred by him.

2. Notice of motion to the respondents.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Sidakmeet Singh Sidhu, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.
4. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that though representation/complaint was made to the Senior Superintendent

of Police, Hoshiarpur-respondent No.2 way-back on February 23, 2016 but till date no substantive action has been taken.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation/complaint dated February 23, 2016 (Annexure P-2) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
