It has inter alia been argued by counsel for the petitioner that the dispute is amongst the neighbours. There is a cross-case also registered against the complainant. The petitioner has not been attributed any injury on the person of deceased Harjit Kaur but there are vague allegations of petitioner having caught hold of deceased from hair and having given slaps and kick blows.

Whether it is a case of self defence or the petitioner exceeded self defence, cannot be adjudicated at this stage.

The petition is dismissed without prejudice to the right of the petitioner to raise all the pleas before the trial Court at appropriate time. It will be appreciated in case the trial is concluded within a period of six months.
