The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in cross version i.e. DDR No.35 dated 02.12.2015 under sections 323, 324, 326, 148 and 149 IPC in case FIR No.171 dated 02.12.2015 under Sections 452, 324, 323, 376, 511 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that cross version has been registered just to save opposite party and to put pressure upon the petitioner whereas no offence was made out against him. The injuries attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature. Compromise has been effected between the parties and copy of the compromise is annexed with the petition at Annexure A-1. The compromise has been signed by both the parties. The petitioner is in custody for the last more than four months.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the role of the petitioner as well as custody period.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the nature of injuries attributed to him, the custody period and also that investigation has been completed and challan has been submitted, no useful purpose would be served by keeping him behind the bars any further. The present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely, Surinder Singh @ Sony is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
