Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioners and the family members of petitioner No.1 and his relatives at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

In compliance of order dated 29.4.2016 of this Court, learned counsel for the petitioners has produced photocopy of FDR of Rs.2 lacs in the name of petitioner No.1. The same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel has filed affidavit of Parminder Singh, PPS, DSP, City Gurdaspur along with copies of statements of the petitioners (Annexures R-I and R-II), which is taken on record.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioners have made statements to the police that they do not perceive any danger from the private respondents.

In view of the above reply as well as statements made by the petitioners, the present petition no more survives and is disposed of as such.
