Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to complete investigation in case FIR No.596 dated 24.11.2013 under sections 420/467/468/471/120-B IPC registered at Police Station Ambala Cantt., District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though the FIR in question was registered on 24.11.2013, but investigation in the case has not been completed so far. He further states that the petitioner has submitted a representation addressed to respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Ambala (Annexure P-5) by way of registered post on 25.1.2016 to expedite

the investigation, but no action has been taken on the said representation till date.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Anil Kumar Chahal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.
