I have considered the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner that it is a case of circumstantial evidence and the material witnesses stand examined.

Taking into consideration the stage of the trial as 30 witnesses out of total 36 witnesses having already been examined, it will not be appropriate for this Court to express any opinion lest it should prejudice the right of the prosecution or the accused.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the trial is not concluded within a period of three months after the next date of hearing, the trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.
