The petitioner is seeking direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation on the complaint made by her and to register a criminal case under Sections 406/498-A/506 IPC against private respondent Nos.4 to 7.

The petitioner made a criminal complaint against the private respondents, whereby allegations of cruelty, demand of dowry and misappropriation of dowry articles have been levelled.

Upon notice, reply on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, in the shape of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Attari, District Amritsar (Rural), has been filed in Court. Same is taken on record. In the reply, it has been stated that after conducting an enquiry, FIR No.46 dated 16.05.2016, under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC has been

Respondent Nos. 5, 6 and 7 have been declared innocent and further investigation is in progress.

Since the FIR has already been registered on a complaint made by the petitioner, no further direction is required to be given in this case.
