This is a petition for regular bail in case bearing FIR No.333 dated 28.09.2015 under Sections 454/380 IPC, later on Section 22/61/85 of NDPS Act and Section 411 IPC and under Section 25, 54,59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar City.

Learned counsel has argued that the application for extension of time was filed on 14. 3.2016 as 180 days were to expire on 27.3.2016 whereas extension was allowed on 28.3.2016 and , therefore , by making the application at that stage the indefeasible right of the applicant could not be taken away. In this reference the question has been referred to a larger bench by order dated 11.9.2014 passed in CRR-2087-2014 and while referring the matter the Hon'ble Court granted interim bail to the petitioner. Learned

Addl. AG has accepted these facts.

In the circumstances the matter is adjourned to be heard after the decision of the aforesaid CRR-2087-2014. In the meantime the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial court.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
