Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect/safeguard the life and liberty of the petitioner at the instance of respondents No.4 to 7.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.
3. At the asking of Court, Mr. Aditya Sanghi, Addl. AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
4. At the very outset learned counsel for the petitioner submits that representation dated December 02, 2015 (Annexure P-5) was moved to the various authorities including respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar but no action has been taken so far and he feels satisfied in case a direction is given to respondent No.2 to dispose of representation Annexure P-5 within a stipulated period.

5. Accordingly, Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into the grievances of petitioner unfolded by him in his representation Annexure P-5 and in case any substance is found therein, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
