RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.

1. This order will dispose of CWP No.3828 of 2000 titled *Gian Kaur and others v. State of Haryana and another*, CWP No.8106 of 2001 titled *Chander Kanta and others v. State of Haryana and others* & CWP No.6233 of 2001 titled *Dalgir Kaur and others v. State of Haryana and others*.

2. Concededly the case is covered by the judgment rendered in

CWP No.8106 of 2001 (O&M)
CWP No.6233 of 2001 (O&M)

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CWP No.22066 of 2012 titled *Ganga Ram Punia and others v. State of Haryana and others* decided on August 17, 2015.

3. In turn, the learned Single Judge relied on the judgment of the Supreme Court in State of Haryana and another v. Partap Singh and others, (2006) 10 SCC 251. It may be mentioned that the ruling in State of Haryana and others v. Sumitra Devi and others, (2004) 12 SCC 322 is distinguishable and has no bearing on this case. This is being recorded in view of the interim order dated October 03, 2016 when the aforesaid two judgments were produced by the learned Law Officer and Mr. Chatrath was granted time to examine them in the light of the present case.

4. In view of the above, finding no merit in these writ petitions, the same stand dismissed.
