FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 14.12.2015 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Chandigarh has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Paramjeet Kaur, injured Sonia and Hukam Chand, as well as the accused persons namely Rajnish Kumar, Rajesh Kumar, Shayne @ Kushal Kapoor and Neeraj, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, the fact that parties belong to the same very area and the offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out

differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.213 dated 04.05.2013 registered at Police Station Sector 39, Chandigarh under Sections 147/148/149/323/324/326/427/506 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
