HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of private respondents No.6 to 11.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though FIR No.352 dated 1.12.2015 under Sections 147, 149, 323, 341 and 506 IPC has been registered at Police Station Pundri against the private respondents, but no action has been taken thereon. He further states that the petitioner is being threatened by respondent No.5 who is posted at Police Post, Pundri and is helping the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already approached the respondent No.3 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Kaithal by way of representation (Annexure P-2) which was diarised on 11.1.2016.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Sulinder Kumar, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting upon the contents of representation (Annexure P-2), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to take note of the contents of said representation and to take appropriate action in accordance with law.
