This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of complaint dated 06.10.2003 in FIR No. 498 dated 19.09.2003 registered under Sections 406, 420, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471-A, 120-B and 109 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Patiala, on the basis of compromise.

On the last date of hearing a copy of the petition was handed over to learned State counsel to seek instructions.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Bhupinder Singh, submits that accused took ₹1.69 crores from 25 persons with the promise that they would be sent abroad. Fake visas were handed over to them. Out of 07 accused in the FIR, 04 have been declared proclaimed offender. According to him, no case for quashing of complaint on the basis of compromise has been made out as only 01 accused has approached this court. He is stated to have entered into compromise with three of the victims. As 04 separate challans were

submitted in the case and there are other aggrieved persons, this petition is misconceived.

I find substance in plea of the State counsel. Under the facts and circumstances of the case no case for quashing of FIR or complaints received by other victims during the proceedings, is made out.

Dismissed.
