Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.71 dated 19.03.2016, under Sections 147, 149, 307, 323 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Jind, District Jind.

Briefly noticed FIR came to be registered on the statement of Rajesh Kumar. Occurrence is stated to be of 19.03.2016. As per complainant's version, 07 persons have suffered injuries.

During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that offence under Section 307 IPC has been cited on account of a gunshot injury suffered by Rambir and specifically attributed to co-accused Mahender son of Rajender. Insofar as the present petitioner is concerned only simple injuries have been attributed.

Petitioner was arrested on 20.03.2016.

Even though the matter is still under investigation yet counsel for the petitioner would inform the Court that a compromise has been effected between the parties and even a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the FIR i.e. CRM No.M-12956 of 2016 has been filed in this Court and which is now slated for hearing on 17.08.2016.

Counsel further submits that after issuance of notice of motion in the quashing petition even the statements of the parties in support of the compromise have already been recorded before the Illaqa Magistrate concerned on 30.04.2016.

In view of the above, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jind.
