Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.68 dated 1.6.2014 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act,PS Kathunangal, Amritsar.

There was recovery of 200 grams of intoxicating powder from the right pocket of the pant of accused petitioner,who was apprehended on spot on 1.6.2014. Due to non-availability of FSL report he was granted interim bail on 25.7.2015 and due to his absence on 2.1.2016 his bail bonds were cancelled and NBWs issued for arrest.

Reason for non-appearance is that the petitioner is employed as a Driver and therefore, unwittingly, could not appear in Court on the date fixed.

It is not disputed that FSL report has since been received according to which seized quantity became commercial in nature.

After hearing counsel for the petitioner, no case for indulgence is made out as the interim bail in any case is liable to be cancelled in the light of quantity being commercial in nature.

Dismissed.
