On the instructions of ASI Sarpal Singh imparted to the State counsel, it has been informed that the petitioner has joined the investigation but has not cooperated.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, it does not appear to be a case where custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required. Petitioner has been involved in the case of an unlawful assembly constituted by dozens of identified persons and 40/50 unidentified persons in about 20 vehicles have fired indiscriminately in front of a college. The petitioner was not armed with any weapon.

In view of the above circumstances of the case, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 02.05.2016 is hereby made absolute, subject to all the conditions under Section 438(2) Cr. P. C.
