In the light of the contentions raised by learned senior counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners had been regularly appearing through their counsel before the trial court and that exemption application was filed by the petitioners which was dismissed and that now non-bailable warrants of arrest have been issued, the present petition, after hearing counsel for the parties and perusal of the record, disposed off with the directions to the petitioners to surrender personally before the learned trial court within one month from today and the learned trial court would release them on bail to
