Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by Salima seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty as well as her family members at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

2. Allegations contained in the petition are that there is a matrimonial dispute. Respondents No.4 to 7 visited the place of petitioner on February 05, 2016 and forcibly took away Rafi aged about 10 years and since then he is in custody of respondents No.4 to 7. It has further been alleged that there being matrimonial differences, respondents No.4 to 7 are extending threats to the life and liberty of the petitioner as well to her family members.

3. This Court has given a deep thought to the allegations contained in the petition as well as submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner but find that the matter is purely of civil nature. There is a matrimonial dispute between the petitioner and respondent No.4. The minor son namely Rafi aged

about 10 years is in the care and custody of respondent No.4 i.e. father, petitioner can avail remedies under the civil Law and take the custody of minor in accordance with law. No case is made out to interfere in the instant petition.

4. Dismissed.
