The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of interim bail to the petitioner for a period of 15 days on the ground that wife of the petitioner is suffering from a serious brain/neuro medical ailment.

It has gone uncontroverted that the petitioner is facing trial for offence under Section 302 IPC pertaining to FIR No.58 dated 11.02.2014, under Sections 148/149/333/353/307/302/120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Model Town, District Rewari.

State of Haryana having been put to notice in this petition, a short reply of the Superintendent, District Prison, Narnaul along with Annexures R-1, R-2, R-3 and R-3A has been filed in Court today and same is taken on record.

In the reply, it has been stated that the petitioner had earlier been released two times on interim bail and on both times, the petitioner had surrendered in time and had not misused the concession. It has also been confirmed that the petitioner's wife is suffering from brain/neuro ailment as

per document at Annexure R-2 i.e. an out patient card issued by Pt. B.D. Sharma PGIMS, Rohtak.

The assertion made on behalf of the petitioner that there is no other male member to look after the wife of the petitioner is also supported by a report of the Sarpanch of the village concerned.

In the light of such circumstances, the limited prayer made by the petitioner for grant of interim bail for a period of 15 days to facilitate immediate medical attention to his wife is accepted.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction for the petitioner to be released on interim bail for a period of three weeks commencing w.e.f. 09.05.2016 subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition would duly surrender on 30.05.2016.
