Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail incase FIR No.265 dated 06.05.2015, registered at Police Station Ratia, District Fatehabad, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 506 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody for the last 09 months and it is a case of Magisterial trial.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, points out that the petitioner has duped the complainant by selling land by impersonation.
