Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioner- Mukesh Lamba in case FIR No.173 dated 17.12.2011, under Sections 341, 323, 324, 379, 148, 149, 326 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Kharar City, Distt. SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Complainant Arwinder Singh and accused party are students of GGS College, Kharar. The complainant is alleged to have been inflicted injury by co-accused Jatinder by a *kirpan* on the left knee and co-accused Gagan @ Moto with *iron pipe* on left leg, co-accused Sunny Rana with his *baseball bat* on his left arm while co-accused Bindrakhia with a *wooden stick* on the right side of his arm.

It was stated that the petitioner-accused has been attributed only role of having *iron pipe* in his hand and as such no injury is attributed to him.

It was contended that co-accused Gagan and Jatinder Singh, who have been attributed injuries, were granted the benefit of pre-arrest bail.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Amar Nath, agrees that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 02.05.2016, is made absolute.
